"kind often meet in the heart of the rock, and,
"like miners in a siege, who sometimes cross
"each other's galleries, they frequently break
"in upon each other's retreats. Whether their
"thus meeting be the work of accident, or of
"choice, few can take upon them to determine; certain it is, they are most commonly
"found in numbers in the same rock; and
"sometimes above twenty are discovered within
"a few inches of each other."

These animals are pretty generally diffused, but they are found in the greatest numbers at Ancona, in Italy; along the shores of Normandy and Poitou, in France; and upon some of the coasts of Scotland. They are generally held as a great delicacy, and in some places are sedulously sought after for the purpose of supplying the tables of the luxurious.
