THE KORSCHUN.

THE new Memoirs of the Academy of Sciences at Petersburg make mention of a variety of the kite* which they call korcshun. The extremity of all the quill feathers is terminated by a border of a chesnut colour: this tint is also to be observed on the head, the nape of the neck, and the neck itself. The membrane of the base of the beak is greenish; the feet are covered with down, and the tail is about a foot long while the body is not more than ten inches in length. It is found towards the river Ural.
