The discrepancies between these birds are to be found only in the colour of their plumage: a deep ferruginous red colour prevails over the whole of the upper part of the body: while the under are of a lighter red, sprinkled with blackish streaks. The feet are yellow; the iris is reddish; the prime quill feathers of the wings are black; the tail is red at top and grey at bottom; the breast and the neck are a whitish grey.
