## THE GREENFINCH OF CHINA.

" THIS bird," says M. Sonnerat, " has some affinity in its colours and in its size, with the greenfinch of Brisson, or the yellowhammer of bird-catchers. The head and the neck are of a greyish green colour; the back and the small feathers of the wings are of a clear brown, except those which are on the edge of the wings, they being black; the shortest of the large feathers of the wings are black on the interior side, and of a reddish grey on the exterior; the largest are yellow for one half of their length, black the rest, and terminated by a grey semicircular stripe; the belly is of an earthy red; the covert feathers of the tail are yellow on the under part; the feathers of the tail are black, terminated by a white stripe; the beak and the feet are of a greenish yellow colour."-See Voyages aux Indes et à la Chine, par M.
