The very extensive race of digitated carnivorous animals with crooked and retractile cla $s$, in which we must comprehend the panther, leopard, guepard, ounce, serval, and cat, with all their varicties. 7. The digitated camivorous animals with straight and fixed claws, which include the wolf, fox, jackal, inatis, and the dog, with all their varieties. S. The digitated camivorous animals with fixed claws, and a pouch under their tails. This consists of the hyena, civet, zibet, badger, \&cc. 9. The digitated camivorous animals with long bodies, five toes to cach foot, and the great toc, or thumb, divided from the rest ; this gcnus is composed of the ferret, martin, pole-cat, weasel, suble, ichneumo:, \&c. 10. The numerous family of digitated quadrupeds which have two large incisive teeth in each jaw, and no bristles on their bodies; this contains the hare, rabbit, and ciery kind of squirrels, dormice, marmots, and rats. 11. The digitated quadrupeds, whese bodies are covered with spiny quills, as the porcupine and hedge-hog. 12. The digitated animals covered with scales, as the long and short-tailed manis, or scaly lizavds. 13.
