on two feet. When erect, he is from three to four feet high. There seem to be different sizes of this species; but after the most careful comparison, we could perceive no other differences between them than the size, which does not proceed from their age; for the small baboon seemed to be an adult as well as the large.

THE MANDRILL.

THIS baboon (fig. 199.) is an ugly disgusting animal; his nose, or rather two nostrils, are flat, from which constantly issues a
thick matter, which he takes care at intervals
to lick off with his tongue and swallow. His
head is large, and muzzle very long. He is
of a squat form, and his posteriors are of a
blood red, his anus is placed almost as high as
his loins, his face is of a bluish colour, and
strongly seamed with wrinkles, which still
increases his frightful and loathsome appearance. He is larger than the baboon, but more
tame and gentle, and seemed to be more tractable
