*Flustra spongiosa*, *Templeton*, in *Mag. Nat. Hist.* ix. 469.

*Hab*, "Found by Robert Brown, Esq. on the coast of Ballycastle,"  
*Templeton*.

"Allied to the preceding: the mouths of the cells with several long setæ. In *pilosa* the mouths of the cells are surrounded by several very short teeth, with only one hair-like appendage. In this species the teeth appear lengthened into long setaceous bristles." *Templeton*.
