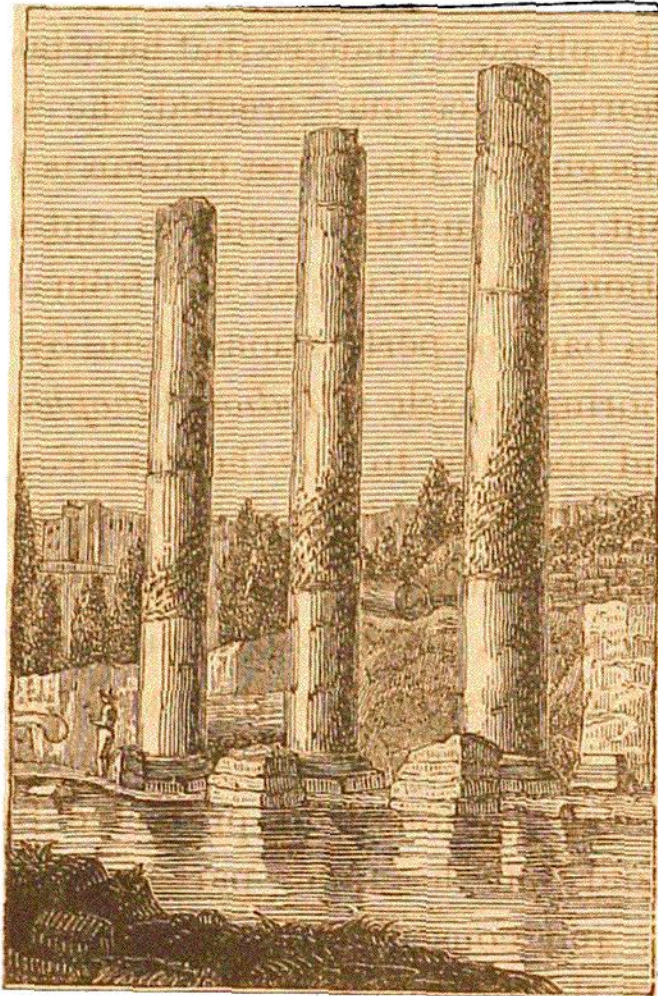

These ruins are situated on the shore of the Bay of Baia, and consist of the remains of a large building of a quadrangular form, seventy feet in diameter; the roof of which was supported by twenty-four granite columns, and twenty-two of marble, each formed of a single stone. Many of the pillars are broken and strewed about the pavement, but three remain standing nearly erect, and
