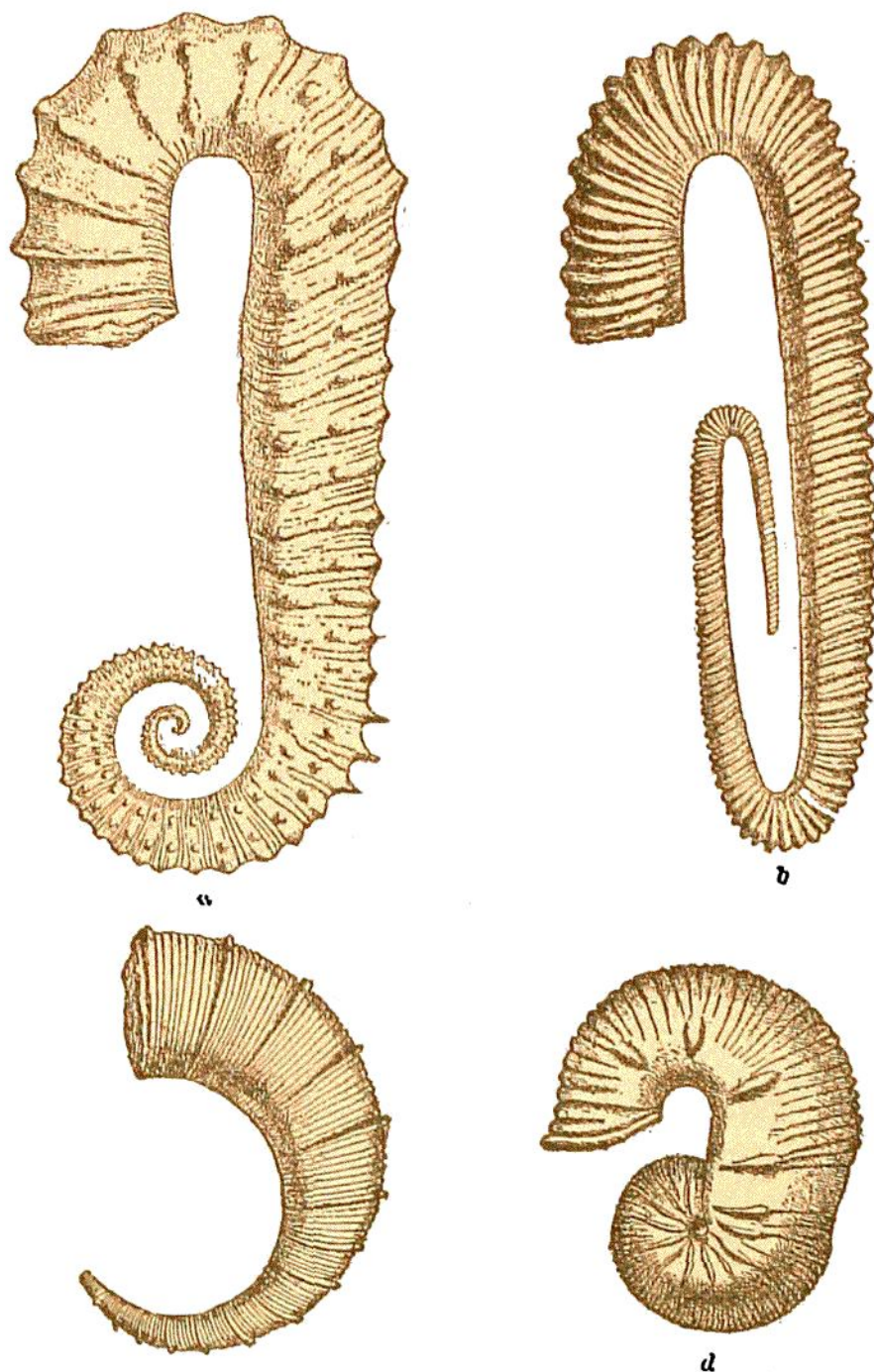


Fig. 418.—Cretaceous Cephalopods.
