which comprehends the apes, baboons, monkies, makis, loris, \&c. 15. The winged quadrupeds, which includes bats, \&c. with all their varieties. The nime detached species are the elephant, rhinnccros, hippopotamus, giraffe, camel, lion, tiger, bear, andmole, which are all subject $t$ a greater or smaller number of varictics.

Of those fiffeen genera, and nine detached species, seven genera and two species are common to both continents. The two suecies are, the bear and the mole; and the even genca are, 1. The great cloven-hoofed with bollow horns, for the ox is found in America, under the form of the bison. 2. The chover- hoofed, with solid horns, for the che exists an Camta, under the name of orignal ; the iciu-tier, under that of caribou; and stags, fllow-deer, and roe-buchs, are found in all the proviness of Nurth America.
