

- 2. Lower red sandstone and magnesian limestone, resting unconformably on transition rocks or coal strata, No. 1.
- 3. Middle and upper red sandstone and marl, with rock salt and gypsum.
- 4. Lias clay and lias limestone.
- 5. Oolite formation, and beds of clay.

N. B. Where the wealden beds occur, they are placed between the oolite and green sand.

- 6. Green sand and chalk.
- 7. Tertiary strata, filling a depression in chalk.

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
