



2. Lower red sandstone and magnesian limestone, resting unconformably on transition rocks or coal strata, No. 1.
3. Middle and upper red sandstone and marl, with rock salt and gypsum.
4. Lias clay and lias limestone.
5. Oolite formation, and beds of clay.
- N. B. Where the wealden beds occur, they are placed between the oolite and green sand.
6. Green sand and chalk.
7. Tertiary strata, filling a depression in chalk.
