

again, leaving certain hollow spaces between them ; their cells are much smaller, though of the same shape with the cells in the foliaceous Millepore" (*E. foliacea*). *Solander*.—Pallas maintains that it is merely a variety of the preceding ; but Milne-Edwards thinks it ought to be retained distinct, for its peculiarity of ramification, and the narrowness of the divisions, do not depend on age, and seem to indicate a specific difference. The cells in both are alike.
