- Fig. 1.—Group of Living COMATULÆ : *nat.* (Dr. Thompson.)
 1a.—A Single COMATULA of the same group, magnified.
 2.—PENTREMITES PYRIFORMIS. *Ohio.*
 3, 4.—Surfaces of two pentepetalous joints or ossicula.
 5.—One of the bones of APIOCRINITES. *Chalk.*
 6.—ENCRINUS LILIIFORMIS; the body and part of the column attached. $\frac{1}{3}$ *nat.* *From Brunswick.*
 7.—PENTACRINITAL stem of four angles.
 8.—ENTROCHITE, composed of five smooth ossicula.
 9.—Quadrangular stem of seven ossicula.
 10.—CYATHOCRINITES TUBERCULATUS. (*Murch. Sil. Syst.*)
 11.—Receptacle of APIOCRINITES; *from the Chalk.* *Lewes.*
