*Conclusion*: Retrospect of the undertaking. Limitation consistent with the nature of a physical description of the universe. Representation of the actual relations of cosmical bodies to each other. Kepler's laws of planetary motion. Simplicity of the uranological problem in opposition to the telluric, on account of the exclusion of material heterogeneity and change.
