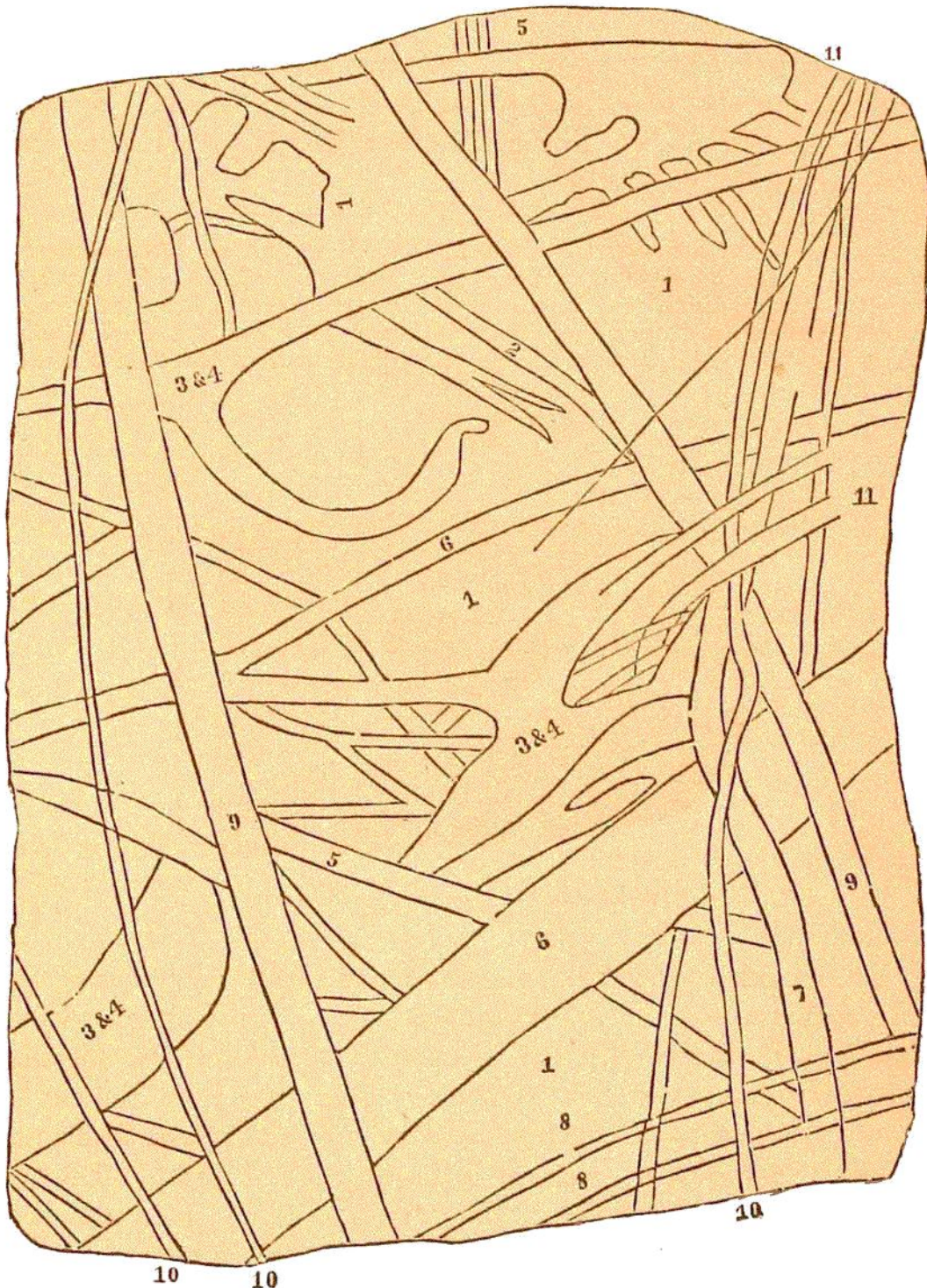


intruded between the strata; and hence have been mistaken for beds, and have given rise to the inquiry whether granite is not stratified.
