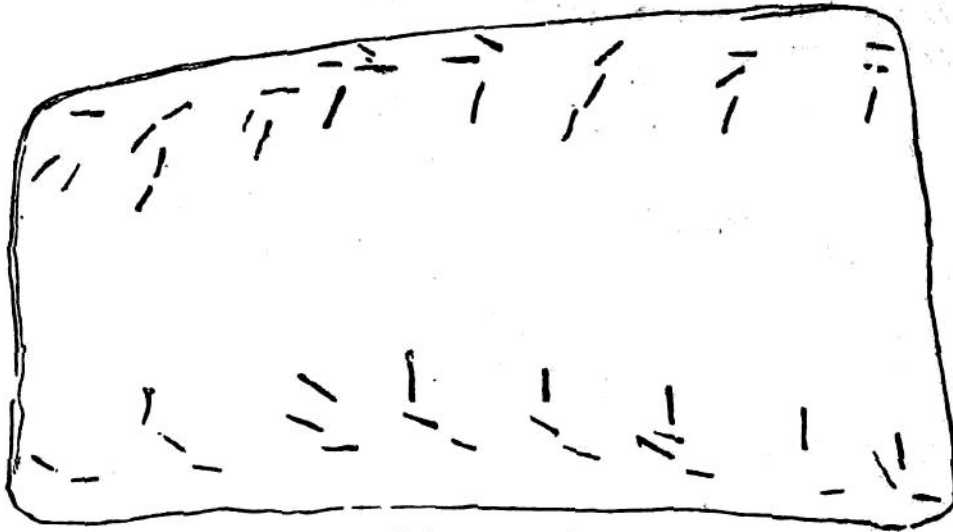

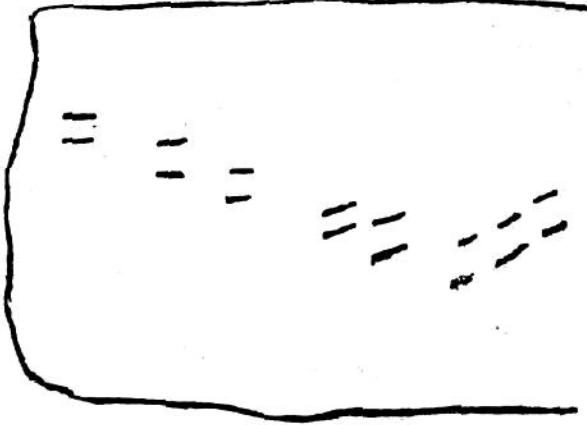
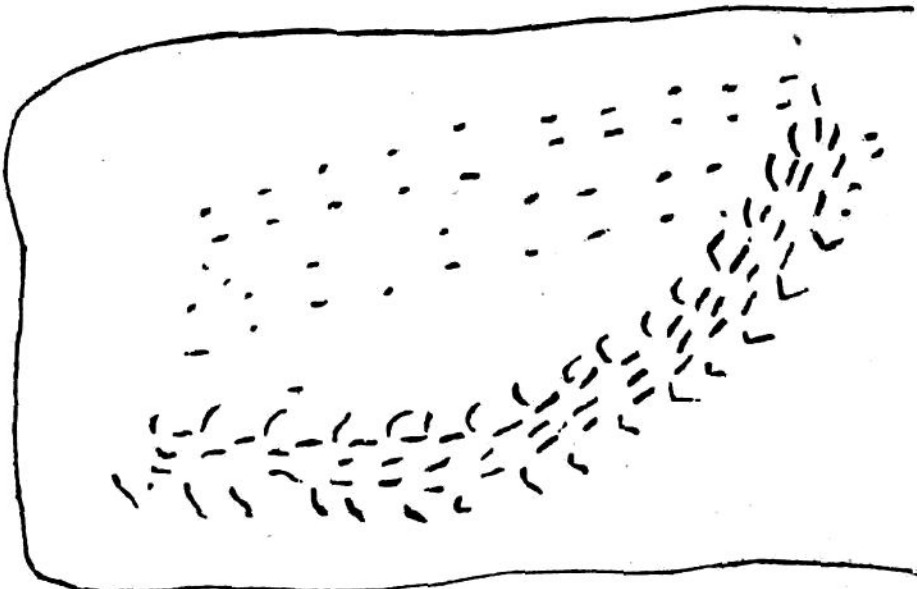
*Acanthichnus cursorius.*
