teaceæ, which comprehends the Banksia, the Hakea, the Gerilea protea, existed in Europe during the Tertiary period. The family of

Mimosas, comprising the Acacia and Inga, which in our age are only natives of the southern hemisphere, abounded in Europe during the same geological period. A branch of Banksia, with its fructification, taken from impressions discovered in rocks of the period, is
