from the works or memoirs of Gosse, Möbius, Verrill, Pourtales, L. Agassiz, A. Agassiz, Smitt, Edwards and Haime, Wilkes and Hartt. In addition, the volume is indebted for a few cuts to the beautifully illustrated popular works, "Le Monde du Mer" and "La Vie et les Mœurs des Animaux;" but nearly half of these were engraved from my plates. The sources of all the figures are given in the List of Illustrations.
